Discussion: regarding development of sales portfolio for use by members at their home shows and in their showrooms. Doug will get together a prototype for use at the HPBA show and for display and comments at the annual meeting. Recommendation: budget up to \$250 for development of prototype.

Discussion: MHA brochure needs to be reordered this year. Will need to have future discussions about content change and/or additions. Recommendation: should be funded through the bookstore and held in inventory. Association should expense copies that are used at HPBA and given away for promotional purposes.

Discussion: Web site improvements. Decided to postpone discussion until the next committee meeting.

Discussion: Public relations newsletter to go out to a general mailing list other than members. Purpose would be to keep these individuals in the "loop" about developments in the masonry heater scene and hopefully solicit associate memberships from this group. Names for the mail list to come from bookstore customers, information inquiries and past members.
