I built the double bell from the MHA portfolio some five years back for a guy down in Dorset. Used hand made Swanage red bricks and clay that was dug up in the garden for mortar. Visited last week for a check up. In mild coastal winters down South they make two fires per week - the only heat source for the (straw bale wrap up) house plus domestic hot water. Thumbs up. Chimney sweep loves it too.

Few infrareds attached - some 6 hours after burning half a load ,')
